WHAT TO DO IF YOU SUSPECT HUMAN TRAFFICKING

-  Do **NOT** attempt to confront a trafficker or alert a victim to your suspicions.
-  Call 911- local law enforcement has been training in investigation techniques. Always call 911 first if there is a threat of violence or an emergency. To report to federal law enforcement call 1-866-347-2423.
-  Follow your corporate protocol, such as alerting management of security.
-  If safe to, and you feel comfortable, use resources like hotline soaps.
-  If a victim need immediate help, refer them to the Advocacy & Resource Center. They have a 24-hour hotline, 307-672-3222.
